WHEREAS, the Town of Clarkdale is updating the General Plan. Focus Groups have been developing policy statements that address the issues raised in their discussions; and

WHEREAS, the next step is to start the actual revision of the existing General Plan elements. That process needs the guiding hand and oversight of a General Plan Update Committee; and

WHEREAS, the original intent of this process was to have one person from each of the focus groups sit on the General Plan Update Committee in order to bring consistency to the revision process.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Clarkdale hereby creates a General Plan Update Committee composed of nine (9) residents of the Town of Clarkdale.

1. The General Plan Update Committee shall elect a Chair and Vice-Chair from among its members.
2. The appointments to the General Plan Update Committee shall be for a term of two (2) years each.
3. Members shall serve without compensation.
4. If any member shall be absent for three (3) consecutive regular meetings, or a cumulative total of seven (7) meetings throughout the fiscal year, he or she shall automatically cease to hold membership without further action being taken by either the General Plan Update Committee or the Town Council. It shall be the responsibility of the Chairperson of the General Plan Update Committee to so notify the Town Council immediately upon the creation of a vacancy.
