Historic Building Tour & Exhibit

Art in Public Places Exhibit

Art in Public Places is currently exhibiting CLARKDALE HOMEMAKER ARTS, an exhibit of quilts, wall-hangings, pictures, pillows, holiday items and hand-sewn functional products, both old and new, created by some of Clarkdale's favorite homemakers. The exhibit will be on display throughout December.

Of special interest are two historic quilts on loan from the Clarkdale Historical Society and Museum. One was presented to the Town of Clarkdale by the Discovery Connection, an after-school and summer program, in honor of the 50th Anniversary of Incorporation on July 4, 2007. The other is a photo quilt of historic people, places and things significant to Clarkdale created to commemorate Clarkdale's 50th Anniversary of Incorporation.
