Help bring the community together by cleaning up the illegally dumped trash and litter that has accumulated along Allen Springs Road in the Prescott National Forest so that the area can be safely enjoyed by all!

Although this is a community project, it is **STRICTLY** volunteer! We ask volunteers to provide their own water, gloves, sun screen, hats and other protective attire. If you cannot make it on the 27th, but would like to be a part of the effort, any donation of the following items would be a huge help:

Essential items are:

- Rollaway Trash Container (s)
- Trash Bags
- A Backhoe with Front Loader
- Refreshments (water, sports drinks, snacks)
- Protective Attire (sun screen, gloves) For Those Volunteers Who Do Not Have Any

Directions to Clean Up Site:

Volunteers should meet at 7:00 a.m. at the cattle guard located 1.35 miles west on Mingus Avenue from 89A (beyond the Cottonwood Airport and Verde Valley Humane Society). The clean up area will be about a half mile beyond this point, and centered in the area formerly used as a community dump and often used as a firearms shooting site (on Forest Road 493).
