June 4 **Heritage Park Zoological Sanctuary & Highlands Center** **9:30a-3:30p**
Senior (65+) \$12, Adult (13+) \$13, Child (3-12) \$10, 2 & under \$5

Come see the native and exotic animals rescued from around the country. See a mountain lion, tiger, bear, pronghorns, mule deer, javelina, Bobcats and more! Enjoy a bag lunch and then travel to the Highland Center for Natural History to enjoy a walk in the Ponderosa forest.

June 18 **Phippen Museum & Prescott** **9a-4p**
Senior/Adult \$12, Students (w/ ID) \$10, Child (12 & under) \$5

Founded to showcase the work of George Phippen, local artist, founding member and first President of the Cowboy Artists of America as well as others. Enjoy art by noted western painters and sculptors as well as western heritage artifacts and memorabilia. After visiting the museum we travel to downtown Prescott to choose from the many restaurants, shops and galleries around Courthouse Square.

July 9 **Riordan Museum & Pioneer Museum** **9a-4p**
Senior (65+) \$22, Adult (14+) \$23, Youth (7-12) \$15, 6 & under \$7

This 1904 duplex home was built for two lumber baron brothers who married two sisters and helped make Flagstaff the community it is today. Enjoy a guided tour of this well preserved master piece for a glimpse back into another time. After a bag lunch continue our history of Flagstaff with a visit to the Pioneer Museum. Housed in the 1908 Coconino County Hospital for the Indigent this collection of artifacts and displays gives another glimpse into early Flagstaff life.

July 23 **Arboretum at Flagstaff & Downtown** **9a-4p**
Senior (65+) \$12, Adult \$14, Child (5-17) \$8, 4 & under \$5

Stroll through gardens filled with flowers, plants, shrubs and trees native to the high elevation habitat of northern Arizona. Enjoy the sights and smells as well as the research and experimentation of native plants and techniques on the grounds of the former home of Frances McAllister who first came to Flagstaff in the 1930's. After the arboretum it is a trip to historic downtown Flagstaff with its restaurants and shops. Spend time enjoying the cool high country air before returning home.
