The Talking Book Library is part of the Arizona State Library, a Division of the Secretary of State. The library provides audio book and Braille services throughout the state for those who find it difficult to read standard print because of visual impairment or physical disability. Talking Book and Braille materials are comparable to reading materials available for circulation at the local public libraries. All materials, including the provided player, are sent postage free through the US Postal service. Everything is provided at no cost to the user, meaning - tax dollars have already paid for this service. We serve all age groups and all reading levels.
