Utilities News

*Water... you just turn on the tap,
and there it is!*

The Town of Clarkdale has now taken
over full responsibility for operation and
maintenance of our water system which includes repairing
water main breaks and leaks. In most cases, repairs to
leaks can be scheduled. Should a scheduled interruption in
water service be required to repair a leak, the Utilities
Department will notify affected residents 24 hours in
advance. When there is an interruption in service due to an
emergency water main repair, our first priority is restoring
service to our customers. In these emergency situations, it
is not always possible to notify residents before shutting the
water off. If you turn on your tap and there is no water,
please call the Utilities Department at 928-639-2520.



A Missed Trash Pick-Up?

If your trash or recycle is not picked up by Tuesday
afternoon, please be sure to contact the Utilities Billing
Department at 928-639-2450 by 3:30 p.m. on the same
Tuesday. This will allow us time to arrange for your trash
service on Wednesday, the next day. Otherwise, your trash
will be picked up the following Tuesday.

Low hanging overhead (power/phone) lines near your
pick-up site can also cause delays in your trash service.
Please contact the appropriate utility company if you see
any low hanging wires to alleviate that problem.

Thank you to all of the residents whose homes
are along an alley, and they have posted their
address numbers at the rear of their property.
This helps to identify your property in an
emergency, and makes finding your address
from the alley easier for utility personnel from
the Town, APS, Unisource, Cable One, etc.

along an alley to come in to Community
Development Department, at 890 Main Street,
and we'll be happy to supply house numbers to
you, at no cost.
