The trick-or-treating route includes: Main Street, 1st North Street and 1st South Street in upper Clarkdale. Remember these streets will be blocked from 4:30 p.m. - 7:15 p.m. and will not be accessible by vehicles. Parking is available at Town Hall and Clarkdale-Jerome School.

Remember to bring a flashlight as this will aid you while travelling through the dark areas as well as with the bumps and dips in the streets and sidewalks.
