Traffic

During the month of September a slight drop in traffic warnings from August was observed. A significant drop in warnings and citations were also observed between the first 9 months of 2011 and the first 9 months of 2012. One of the many duties of the Clarkdale Police Department is to educate the motorists that drive within our jurisdiction. To do so, traffic stops are made on the motorists that show a deficiency in their knowledge of the Arizona state traffic codes. Those motorists that are contacted will be counseled in regards to their violation of the traffic codes and issued a verbal or written warning for minor violations. When a severe violation is observed that motorist is issued a citation for their actions. The decrease in the amount of warnings issued validates the previous educational contacts the Clarkdale Police Department has had with motorists within our jurisdiction, and shows that the motoring public is learning to obey the traffic laws in Clarkdale. Officers of the Clarkdale Police Department are always on the lookout for drivers that need remedial lessons relating to traffic laws and safe driving.

Crime

During the month of September an overall drop in crime was noted. Currently an investigation relating to a sexual assault is being investigated in conjunction with the Yavapai Apache Police Department. During an investigation by the Yavapai Apache Police Department it was discovered that a sexual assault occurred between two tribal members within the jurisdiction of Clarkdale. Upon the discovery of the incident the Yavapai Apache Police Department contacted the Clarkdale Police Department and a joint investigation is ongoing.
