Traffic

The monthly report shows a decrease in both citations and written warnings issued. The number of verbal warnings for infractions increased during this month. Clarkdale Officers increased traffic enforcement in the Centerville neighborhood this past month due to complaints received about speeding and stop sign violations. Few infractions were observed by the officers as the result of the increased enforcement.

Crime

Burglary. The Clarkdale Police Department investigated two reported burglaries during the month of November. The first reported incident was the burglary of a home in Mountain Gate where property was reported to have been taken but no sign of forced entry was located. The second reported burglary involved the theft of aluminum cans from a locked recycle collection point.

Trespassing. Two incidents of trespassing were reported for November. The first reported incident involved a homeowner who located footprints in his fenced yard near where property was identified as missing. The missing item was later located in a secure area on the property. The second incident occurred when an intoxicated subject attempted to enter a home without success. The home was thought to be the home of a friend but was not. The subject was charged with criminal trespass.

Due to the small amount of trespassing calls responded to by the Clarkdale Police Department any increase in call activity reflects a dramatic increase in statistics. The crime report for the month of October showed a reported 200% increase year-to-date in trespass, a change from 5 trespass calls in 2011 to 15 in 2012. The two reported incidents of trespassing for the month of November, 2012, increased the year-to-date percentage to 240%.

EMS/Rescue/Fire Calls. EMS/Rescue/Fire Calls show an increase of 300% from October to November (from 1 to 4.) Clarkdale Officers receive notification for all calls that the Clarkdale Fire District is dispatched to. When available or requested, Clarkdale Officers respond to assist Fire District personnel. In November, Clarkdale Officers responded to assist with three EMS type calls and one fire call involving a small brush fire.
