Traffic

During the month of December the Town of Clarkdale experienced two major traffic incidents. The first was on 12/13/12 where a CTI truck rolled in the roundabout located at State Highway 89A and Avenida Centerville. The investigation revealed that the accident was caused when the center of gravity of the load within the tankers shifted as the driver started to exit the roundabout. The Management at CTI has been contacted in reference to the installation of a shaker pad at their terminal that would help to settle the load in the trailers prior to their trucks entering the public roadway.

The second major traffic incident was a single vehicle rollover accident at Centerville and Broadway. The accident resulted in minor injuries to the occupants of the vehicle. The driver of the vehicle is currently under investigation (awaiting lab results on the driver's blood) for being under the influence (DUI) while driving.

Crime

On 12/26/12 the Police Department responded to the Waste Water Treatment Plant construction site in reference to a delayed burglary. Sometime during the Christmas weekend an unknown subject entered the fenced construction site and removed four trail cameras that had been placed by the contractor to monitor and record the project progression. Also taken from the construction site was a power cable that supplied power from a generator to a welder unit. The final item taken was a small acetylene tank.

One of the items taken from the site was a critical piece of equipment needed for the ongoing installation of the treatment plant. Had the contractor not had a backup welding system on hand the theft of the power cable could have delayed the ongoing work until a replacement power cable was obtained. It is unknown if the theft of the power cable was meant to delay the project or for the value of the salvaged copper found within the cable.

The evidence indicated that the suspect had inside knowledge of the placement of the trail cameras and combinations to the locks that secured the construction area. The investigation is ongoing.

Crime (continued)

On 12/20/12 the Police Department responded to 380 Rincon Drive (Wolf Insulation) in reference to a delayed report of criminal damage. The investigation revealed that unknown subjects had failed in an attempt to set two vehicles on fire by inserting rags into the fuel tanks and setting them on fire. No leads have been developed relating to a suspect. This investigation is also ongoing.

On 1/2/13 Clarkdale Police Officers assisted the PANT team in the execution of a search warrant in uptown Clarkdale.
