Clarkdale Town Council Accepting Applications For College Committee

Clarkdale, AZ (September 9, 2014) – The Yavapai College District Governing Board has asked each of the cities and towns in the Verde Valley, the two Supervisors representing County District's 2 and 3, and the Yavapai-Apache Nation to submit two nominees to serve on the College's newly approved Verde Valley Advisory Committee. When establishing the Committee, the District Governing Board established their vision that the committee would be recognized as the Verde Valley's voice for constructive and collaborative dialog between residents and the Yavapai College District Governing Board to promote improved access to quality higher education.

After discussion at their meeting on September 9th, the Clarkdale Town Council directed the Town staff to solicit Letters of Interest and Statements of Qualification from Clarkdale residents who were interested in being considered for nomination to the Committee.

Interested citizens should submit their Letter of Interest and Statement of Qualifications to Clarkdale Town Clerk Kathy Bainbridge by 12:00 p.m. on Friday, September 19, 2014. Materials can be submitted in person at the Town Clerk's office located at 39 N. 9th Street in Clarkdale, by email to townhall@clarkdale.az.gov or by mail to P.O. Box 308, Clarkdale, AZ 86324 (if submitted by mail, please allow enough time for the materials to be received by the deadline).

The Clarkdale Town Council will make their two nominations during their Council meeting to be held at 3:00 p.m. on September 23, 2014. Those nominations will be forwarded to Yavapai County Schools Superintendent Tim Carter, who, on behalf of the Yavapai College District Governing Board, will narrow the list of nominees and appoint one representative from each jurisdiction.
