The Northern Arizona Council of Governments (NACOG) is pleased to announce the appointment of Clarkdale Town Councilman Curt Bohall, and Community Development Director Sherry Bailey to two of its committees.

Councilman Bohall will be serving on the Transportation Policy Advisory Committee (TPAC). The TPAC is a 12-member committee, which makes recommendations to the NACOG Regional Council regarding transportation issues, policies and programs.

Ms. Bailey will serve on the Economic Development Council, a 26-member committee that makes recommendations to the Regional Council regarding projects and issues to promote economic growth in the region.

Councilman Bohall and Ms. Bailey will be working with representatives from across northern Arizona while serving on their respective committees.

NACOG is a group of local governments in northern Arizona working together to solve common problems that transcend the boundaries of each city, town, and county member entity. The Regional Council, comprised of public and private sector officials that are appointed or elected by their respective governments, governs this not-for-profit corporation. The NACOG region covers Apache, Coconino, Navajo, and Yavapai Counties, and the cities and towns within their borders. NACOG undertakes such regional planning issues as infrastructure development, transportation, water quality, wastewater, and provides numerous human service programs to area residents.
