Vaccines provided this year:

■ Influenza (FLU)

Due to COVID 19 related supply, the vaccines below may or may not be available at your clinic. If interested in receiving any of them, ask the clerical staff about availability at that clinic.

- **Tdap** Tetanus/Diphtheria and Acellular Pertussis (whooping cough)
- **Pneumovax 23 (2 or more in lifetime)**
- **MMR** (Measles, Mumps and Rubella)

Immunizations other than Influenza (flu) are available in limited supply.

Payment

- ✓ Insurance ID is required: **Bring your BCBS, or United Health Care or Medicare ID Card.**
- ✓ No cost to employees/dependents covered under your medical plan for flu shots and eligible immunizations.
- ✓ Most BCBS & United Health plans accepted **Medicare covers: Flu and Pneumonia only**
- ✓ Claim filed for member. **Claim filing does not guarantee coverage**
- ✓ Cash Prices: Flu \$55.

Why are flu shots important in 2020?

- Because of the COVID-19 impact on the need for hospital beds the seasonal influenza adds additional need when beds are scarce.
- Burden of flu 2019-2020 (may increase)
 - 35,520,883 symptomatic
 - 490,561 Hospitalizations
 - 35,000 deaths
 - 16,520,350 office visits

Who should receive a flu shot?

- Everyone 6 months or older
- People at high risk for serious flu complications
- This includes young children, pregnant women
- Those with chronic medical conditions
- Anyone who wants protection against the flu
- Those caring for immunocompromised persons
