SALES TAX INCREASE

On August 13, 2019, the Town of Clarkdale Council approved Ordinance #398 to increase the Transaction Privilege Tax (TPT).

The Local Sales Tax is increased from 3.00% to 3.50%

The Construction Tax is increased from 4.00% to 4.50%

Changes are effective November 1, 2019

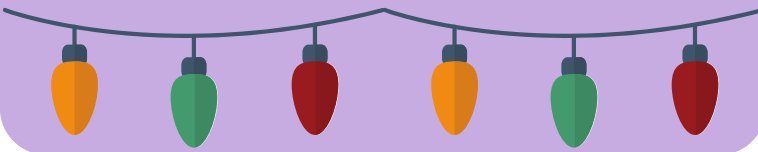
